## Tender and Contract updates

Sefton Carers Centre has been successful in being awarded the contract tendered by Sefton Council for Carers Support Services and our Direct Payment Support Service and Payroll.

The contract will be in place for 3 plus 2, 1-year extensions, and will enable the Centre to plan its activity over this period, enabling longer contracts for staff and more security for our services to develop.

The Centre will be working with the Council and Health Services to improve support for carers and work towards the priorities developed in the recently agreed All Age Carers Strategy.

## Annual Carers Survey - Sefton Carers Centre

Our Annual Survey will be live during January 2026 and will be open for approx. 6 weeks. Confirmation of dates will be available as soon as we finalise the survey.



This year our insights from the survey will focus on the priorities of the All Age Carers Strategy, [Sefton All Age Carers Strategy 2025-2028](https://sefton-carers.org.uk/2025/02/17/sefton-all-age-carers-strategy-2025-2028/) (<https://sefton-carers.org.uk/2025/02/17/sefton-all-age-carers-strategy-2025-2028/>) developed with Sefton Council and partners.

The strategy runs from 2025 – 2028 and the priorities include:

- Identifying Carers
- Information and Advice
- Empowering Carers
- Health and wellbeing
- Carers Assessments.

The survey will focus on feedback from Parent Carers and Adult Carers.

We plan to undertake a focussed survey with our young carers and young adult carers in the new year at the time of Young Carers Week.

# Carers Rights Day



The theme for this year's **Carers Rights Day on Thursday 20 November 2025** is **'Know your rights, use your rights.'**

As a carer, understanding your rights can empower you with the right information about what you're entitled to. This helps you feel confident about asking for what you need, as well as challenging things when your rights are not being met – whether that be in the workplace or education, in accessing health or social care, when interacting with other professionals or at home.

These rights include:

- The right to unpaid carers leave
- The right to flexible working
- The right to ask your GP to identify you as a carer
- The right to access a free flu jab
- Protection against discrimination and harassment
- The right to a carers assessment
- The right to be consulted when the person you care for is being discharged from hospital.

This online resource has been developed in partnership with the Centre and will be packed with lots of information, including details of carers rights, elearning modules, videos, guides and a whole range of tools to help carers.

With health and wellbeing, support for your caring role, financial planning, help with technology and much more, we will ensure this fantastic resource assists carers across Sefton in their caring roles.

We are going to launch the programme on Carers Rights Day and will have access to computers with support from staff to help carers see the system and what it offers.

## **999ReUnite Wristbands**

The Centre in partnership with Sefton Council are providing FREE 999ReUnite Wristbands to unpaid carers and families living in Sefton to support with their caring role and give peace of mind.

The wristbands, are powered by Lumiiio and will hold vital information to support the person you care for or for yourself as a carer. This information could be as simple as letting someone know in an emergency that you have a dog alone at home or who can be contacted to support your loved one in the event of an emergency.

The wristband is waterproof, soft and easily adjustable. Carers can change or remove information as required. No batteries are needed, and no tracking is involved. Information stored on the device is accessible via tapping with a mobile phone.





## Mental Health Project – update

SCC has been working alongside voluntary, community and faith (VCF) partners and Merseycare NHS Trust in supporting people who care for a person with mental health issues to access support around, finances, counselling and carers support.

More work is needed to develop the project which was piloted during 2025, with SCC having some real success in supporting peer groups in the north and south of the borough, alongside some individual counselling support being provided.

We are not certain how the project will develop or if future funding will be agreed, and will update as we know more. We are hoping that the support networks developed can be maintained going forward.

## Neighbourhood Health Programme

Sefton has been officially named as one of the first areas in England to lead the rollout of the NHS new Neighbourhood Health Programme - a flagship initiative aimed at transforming how health and care services are delivered in local communities.

Backed by £10 million in national funding shared across all 43 sites, the programme aims to develop integrated neighbourhood health systems that bring care closer to home, particularly for people living with multiple long-term conditions.

- Moving health care from hospital to the community so that GPs working with acute hospitals and Council Locality Teams can support people to address wider determinants of health such as access to housing, leisure and community support.
- Community nurses and social workers working with GPs to identify those who need support and care early.
- Better access to healthcare for children and young people with teams wrapped around schools.
- A focus on people who need more support to manage their complex health and social care needs such as those with severe and enduring mental health issues.

**The programme is a key part of the Government's 10-Year Health Plan, which aims to shift care from hospitals to communities, move from analogue to digital services, and focus on prevention rather than treatment.**

We will look to get updates as the programme develops.
